

Bread & Butter Screenprinting Design Lab Quick Start Guide

- 1) Please select the number of ink colors that you would like to use in your design. Please note that we have a 12 shirt minimum per ink color.
- 2) In the upper right corner please select Login or Create an Account. In order to save a design you will need to create an account. Once the account is created and verified via email you will be ready to go.
- 3) You can select and change shirt color by clicking on "Product Colors" and then selecting from the options. Please note all colors are subject to availability at the time of ordering.
- 4) You can select print position by hovering over the shirt in the Print Locations window. To select a print position please select the text denoting the position. This choice can be altered as you go, but it is best to decide upon the position before setting up a design.
- 5) To add clipart simply click on the Add Clipart tab at the top. You can choose from categories or from the randomized selections. Clipart can be moved, proportionally rescaled and deleted by clicking on the arrows or the "X" that appears when clipart is selected.
- 6) Once you have placed the clip art you can edit the ink color information by clicking on the buttons in the color management window. Be sure to consider how the colors will interact with the shirt colors. For multicolor clip art we recommend the Full Color setting.
- 7) Once you have placed the clip art you can edit the clip art with the editing tool windows (descriptions appear as you hover over the button). For specific details on these options please see our tutorial.
- 8) To add text to your design simply click on the Add Text tab at the top. Replace "Edit Text" in the window with the text that you would like in your design. We recommend creating separate text windows for each line of text. Having separate text windows allows for more control when designing.
- 9) Text can be edited, change color and have effects applied all in the pop up window. For specific details on these options please see our tutorial.
- 10) Once the design is as you would like it please save your design by clicking on the "Save Design" tab at the top. Please name your design for easier sorting. Once the design is saved successfully a small window will pop up saying "Design saved successfully". The designs are saved to our server for easy access.
- 11) To place an order or get a quote for the design, simply drop us an email, letting us know the name of your saved design.
- 12) To view your saved designs please click on "My Saved Designs"
- 13) To create multiple variations from the same idea or to create several different designs in one session please select "Create New Design From" while viewing your saved designs. You cannot save multiple versions of a design simply by renaming each saved version. Please note that if you continue to work on a design after saving, the new work will write over the old.
- 14) Please note that this design lab is simply a place to experiment and try out ideas. Visualization is an empowering part of the tshirt making process. You might notice the shopping cart, online ordering and invoice tabs and links. Please note that these are not currently active. We want to offer a place for you to simply try out your design ideas.
